

FACE MASK EXEMPTIONS

The Department of Education & Training's COVID Safe Plan for Schools has been developed with the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS). In accordance with the COVID Safe Plan, secondary school students aged 12 years and over must wear a face mask while at school and while travelling to and from school. A fitted face mask that covers the nose and mouth, designed to protect from COVID-19, must be worn. Scarves, bandanas or loose snoods are not appropriate.

Exemptions

Some students are exempt from these requirements. The same exemptions to the wearing of face masks apply in schools as when people are out in the community. This includes students who are over the age of 12 and are unable to wear a face mask due to the nature of their disability. This also includes students who have a medical condition, such as problems with their breathing, a serious skin condition on the face, a disability or a mental health condition.

What do I do if my child should be exempt from wearing a face mask?

If your child requires exemption from wearing a face mask whilst on College grounds, please complete the form below and return it to the General Office. Once the exemption is confirmed, your child will be provided with an Exemption Card which they will be required to carry with them during their time on College grounds.
