

## MOBILE PHONES EXCEPTION APPLICATION

A new Mobile Phone Policy will come into effect from Term 1, 2020. The new policy is a ministerial policy formally issued by the Minister for Education under Section 5.2.1(2)(b) of the *Education and Training Reform Act 2006*. The policy establishes that phones brought to school must be switched off and stored securely during the school day.

In emergencies, parents can contact their children through the College General Office.

A small number of exceptions to the Mobile Phone Policy may be applied during school hours if certain conditions are met. These exceptions can be granted by the Principal (or nominee). Exceptions <u>must be</u> documented.

Where an exception is granted, the student can only use the mobile phone for the purpose for which it was granted.
